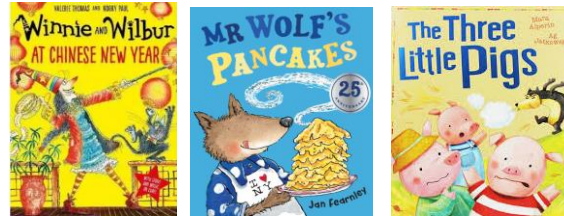

Phonics

- To continue to embed Phase 2 and 3 phonemes to include (ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, er)
- To continue to blend CVC words.
- To read longer words with digraphs and trigraphs and more than 3 phonemes.
- To spell longer words and write short sentences.

Handwriting: to learn the pencil grip and form some letters.

Outcomes

- I can write a list and label a picture using our knowledge of phonics.
- I can compare different weights of objects.
- I can understand the past through settings, characters and events in books read in class and storytelling.
- I will begin to identify signs of Spring.
