## Phonics

- To continue to embed Phase 2 and 3 phonemes.
- To continue to blend CVC words.
- To read longer words and words with endings.
- To read Phase 4 words.
- To spell longer words and write short sentences.

**Handwriting:** to learn the pencil grip and form some letters.

## Outcomes

- I can identify some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country.
- I can express my feelings using a range of different media.
- I can talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society.
- I will understand some important processes and changes in the natural world.

## Maths

- We will embed our knowledge of number and counting to 10 and then to 20.
- Counting on and back from numbers within 0-10, discuss addition and subtraction.
- Be able to represent and count groups up to 20.
- Recognise numerical patterns, including doubling, halving and odds and evens.
