### SCIENCE

We will be identifying a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard and how we can describe their properties. We will also answer our big question 'How can we describe materials?'

### GEOGRAPHY and HISTORY

In Geography we will be answering the big question 'How can I describe my local area?' where we will be looking at the locality of the Isle of Wight and its rural and urban features.

In History we will be answering the big question 'What toys and games did my Grandparents play?' and having a visit from Estelle from the History museum to show us a range of old toys. We will be linking this learning to our Science and discussing how materials for toys have also changed over time.

### ART, DT and MUSIC

In Art, we will be learning the song 'Hey you!' and looking at rap music.

In Music, we will be listening and appraising songs, singing and performing with instruments.
