SCIENCE

We will be exploring the concept of light this term and we will be able to answer the big question: why does my shadow change? We will consider how light travels; how light behaves when it hits objects; and how do we see. We will carry out research and practical, investigative tasks in order to explore these ideas. We will have the opportunity to share our findings with our classmates.

GEOGRAPHY and SPANISH

Our Geography topic this term is: extreme earth! We will look at the extreme weather that has occurred this year. We will study its effect on human geography. We will also study the effects of earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanic activity in countries such as Indonesia, China, Japan and Russia.

In Spanish, we will ask and answer questions about where we live using compass points to describe location. We will learn different uses of 'ser' and 'estar' and then we will use the third person singular conjunction of 'estar' + 'en' + 'de' to talk about where places are. We will also learn the names of typical buildings and amenities in a town.

ART and MUSIC

This term we will be focusing on creating landscapes using linear and atmospheric perspective. We will experiment with different media: watercolours and collage.

In music, we are learning the song 'Make you feel my love' by Adele and also playing the glockenspiel to accompany the song.
